



Certification Rules

- All G365 tournaments are grade based. However, we do allow age exceptions based on the AAU age cutoff dates.
 - Example: If a 12U/6th grade player's birthdate is on 9/21/04 and he is a 7th grader, he would still be eligible for the 6th grade division. Please see the separately attached document for the age guidelines.
- All teams must present a report card or birth certificate for each player. Birth certificates are necessary for age exceptions.
- All teams must be certified thirty minutes prior to their first game at the designated team check-in.
- All players must be on the roster at the team certification before their first game. Any player not listed on the team roster will not be eligible to play in the playoff/bracket round. If a player misses the first day of the event, he or she may still play the next day if they are listed on the certified roster sheet.
- If a team does not follow the certification process, they may be removed from the tournament without a refund.
- An opposing coach can submit a challenge of a player's grade with a \$50.00 deposit. Parents or fans associated with a team may not protest. The protest must come from the head coach or the one assistant coach that is allowed on the bench per team. Protest must be done before the game. If a player in question comes after the start of the game, the request must be filed within 30 minutes of the game's completion.
