



2017 Summer Camp Itinerary

Camp Rules & Procedures

- All players must bring a basketball and water
- Players must check in and out each day of the camp
- Parents are welcome to attend any portion of the camp
- Parents are allowed to take pictures and videos at the camp
- No player is allowed to leave the facility without a parent present
- Players may request to play on a team with a friend but requests are not guaranteed
- Any player who brings money for lunch and vending machines is **solely** responsible for that money
- Open Gym Premier is not responsible for any lost and stolen items
- Open Gym Premier does not have a lost and found – American Sports Center has a lost and found at the front office as well as a lost and found hotline
- Players must get permission from staff member to use the restroom
- Players under 8 years old must be accompanied by a staff member to entrance of restroom
- Players over 8 years old must go with a buddy to the restroom, after getting permission from staff member
- Players may **never** leave Open Gym Premier courts without staff's permission
- Player's parent or carpool must check-in and check-out each player daily
- No refunds are provided to players who do not remain at the camp for the full day or full week
- If a player has not been picked up by 4:15pm, a phone call will be made to parents. If player is not picked up by 4:30pm, there will be a \$40 late fee assessed immediately



Guidelines and Schedule

Guidelines

- Open for boys and girls, 7-14 years old
- Parents must sign in / sign out their child(ren) before and after camp
- Players must bring a basketball and water
- Please bring a **SMALL** gym bag or baller bag for personal items
- Players must use the buddy system when going to the bathroom
- No player will be allowed outside for any reason during the camp
- No player is allowed on the westside of the facility at any time
- Coaches will take roll call multiple times a day
- Players **MUST** tell their coach if they are leaving early and sign out
- Lunch will be available for purchase at the cafeteria
- Each player will receive a report card at the end of the week
- Camp photo will be made available digitally
- All players will receive a camp t-shirt
- Regular camp hours: 9:00 - 4:00 PM
- Extended hours: 8:00 - 5:00 PM
